WHEREAS, Christian Andres B. Borromeo won a Gold Medal and the Overall Champion in Primary 4-6 Category during the 2024 International Youth Piano Online Competition organized by the Asia-Pacific Children and Youth Talent Association and UK Association for Gifted and Talented Children in Hongkong;

WHEREAS, Christian Andres B. Borromeo also won a Silver Medal in 2023 Grand Opus International Piano Competition Solo Rounds and participated in the Orchestra Finals in Vietnam;

WHEREAS, Christian Andres B. Borromeo won 3rd Prize in A2 Etude Category in 2024 Piano Teachers' Guild of the Philippines Foundation, Inc. (PTGPF) Etude and Filipino Words Piano Competition 2024;

WHEREAS, Christian Andres B. Borromeo is also a 2024 Silver Medalist during the 2024 Hongkong International Mathematics Olympiad and 2024 Hongkong International Science Olympiad;

WHEREAS, Christian Andres B. Borromeo is also a 2024 Bronze Medalist during the 2023-2024 Thailand International Mathematical Olympiad and 2023-2024 Greater Bay Area Mathematical Olympiad;

WHEREAS, all these achievements were made possible through early intervention and the continuous efforts to engage Christian in various fields including his early exposure to different activities, especially in music, but most of all is the unwavering support of his family and mentors who allowed him to cultivate his skills and excel in his chosen fields;

WHEREAS, Christian's mother has been a strong advocate for early intervention and free access to therapies for children with autism. She believes that every child deserves the opportunity to develop their full potential, regardless of their family's financial situation. As early intervention programs and therapies are often expensive, many parents struggle to afford the necessary treatments that can significantly improve their child's condition. Through her advocacy, Christian's mother hopes to raise awareness about the importance of making these essential services more accessible to all families, ensuring that children with autism can thrive, just as Christian has.


