*WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government continues to strengthen its disaster readiness and community resilience through systems that provide timely and accurate information during emergencies;*

*WHEREAS, the iRISEUP platform delivers real time weather updates, air quality information, hazard alerts, and other essential advisories that support household and community preparedness;*

*WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides the General Welfare Clause mandating all local government units to enact measures that promote public safety, protect life and property, and enhance resilience against disasters and hazards;*

*WHEREAS, barangays serve as the first line of response and are responsible for mobilizing communities, disseminating information, and ensuring preparedness at the grassroots level;*

WHEREAS, encouraging residents to download, register, and use the iRISEUP application helps strengthen early warning efforts and improves local response during emergencies.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all barangays and relevant local government offices in Quezon City to actively promote and utilize the iRISEUP (Intelligent, Resilient, and Integrated Systems for the Urban Population) platform as part of the City's disaster preparedness and risk reduction efforts.


