ORDINANCE Numbered 94

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING LICENSE FEES ON THE MANUFACTURE OF ICE-DROP, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. License - No person or entity shall conduct or engage in the business of manufacturing ice-drop without first having obtained a permit from the Mayor and the license from the City Treasurer.

SEC. 2. Fees - For every license granted as herein provided there shall be charged the following quarterly license fee based on the number of horse power used by a factory, as scheduled below:

|  | <u>Quarterly license</u> |
|--|--------------------------|
| Class A - Those having machinery with 20 or more horse power - - - - -   | ₱ 37.50                  |
| Class B - Those having machinery with 10 but less than 20 h.p. - - - - - | 30.00                    |
| Class C - Those having machinery with 5 but less than 10 h.p. - - - - -  | 25.00                    |
| Class D - Those having machinery with 3 but less than 5 h.p. - - - - -   | 20.00                    |
| Class E - Those having machinery with less than 3 h.p. - - - - -         | 12.50                    |
| Class F - Those without machinery - - - - -                              | 7.50                     |

SEC. 3. Application - The owner or manager of a establishment shall, before operating the business, file an application with the Office of the City Mayor giving full statement of his establishment, sanitary conditions, the kind of machinery to be used with the number of horse power, and must comply first with all requirements of the City Engineer and City Health Officer.

SEC. 4. Penalty - Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five pesos (₱25.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (₱200.00) or by imprisonment for not less than ten (10) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 5. Repealing Clause - That portion of ordinance or ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
