TAN, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A PROPOSED TWO (2)-STOREY COMMERCIAL BUILDING WITH MEZZANINE LOCATED AT LOT 27, BLOCK 330, PALANAN STREET CORNER SGT. D.M. ALCARAZ STREET, BARANGAY ST. PETER, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016

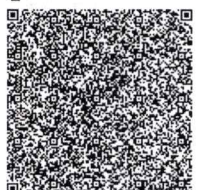
WHEREAS, RJT Golden Circle Enterprise, Inc., as represented by Richard U. Tan, is applying for a Certificate of Exception for the construction and operation of a Proposed Two (2)-Storey Commercial Building with Mezzanine located at Lot 27, Block 330, Palanan Street corner Sgt. D.M. Alcaraz Street, Barangay St. Peter, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 55, Article VIII of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, exceptions and variances or deviations from the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance may be allowed only upon authorization by the City Council, through a Resolution;

WHEREAS, the proposed project will not adversely affect public health, safety, and welfare and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

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WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with all the necessary requirements prescribed by law, ordinance, or administrative issuances in its application for the construction of the aforementioned project;

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted all the necessary and mandatory requirements in support of the proposed project and has committed to comply with the provisions of existing laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations pertaining to public safety, environmental protection, and vehicular traffic.


NOW, THEREFORE,

Tan, for the construction and operation of a Proposed Two (2)-Storey Commercial Building with Mezzanine located at Lot 27, Block 330, Palanan Street corner Sgt. D.M. Alcaraz Street, Barangay St. Peter, District I, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the restrictions provided under Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.
