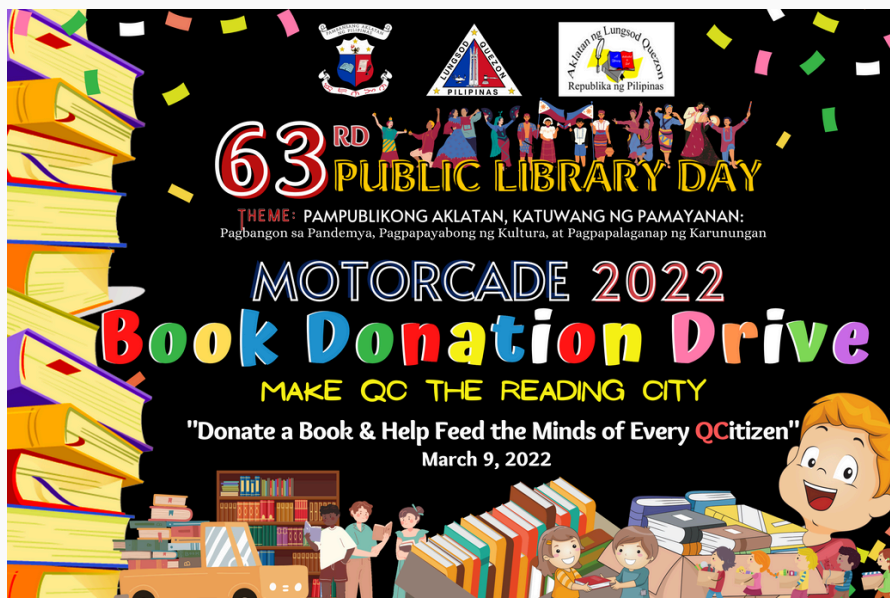

Establishing a Public Library: A Call to Action

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 7743 – An Act providing for the establishment of Congressional, City and Municipal libraries and Barangay Reading Centers throughout the Philippines, appropriating the necessary funds therefore and for other purposes, the District II library staff with the initiative of Ms. Chona Masbate (District II Libraries Supervisor) had an opportunity to meet with the five (5) Barangay Captains of District II in Quezon City last February 14, 2022. The meeting aimed to discuss and encourage each Barangay Captain (1) to establish a public library in the community as mandated by R.A. 7743 (2) services be offered by the library anchored to education and other related programs to all walks of life and (3) other related concerns (book acquisition, staff, organization, etc.)

A public library is defined as an organization established (Gill, 2001)[1], supported and funded by the community, either through local, regional or national government or through some other form of community organization. It provides access to knowledge, information, lifelong learning, and works of the imagination through a range of resources and services and is equally available to all members of the community regardless of race, nationality, age, gender, religion, language, disability, economic and employment status and educational attainment.

The importance of organizing a public library in every barangay is to provide varied resources and services to meet the needs of individuals residing in each barangay and neighboring barangays. Library services that would be beneficial to the community includes: Educational program, Livelihood program, Outreach activities like book and gift giving, Tutorials, Storytelling, Reading tutorials, free use of computers including E-Govt. services – a service that caters online assistance in the application of NBI, SSS, and the likes. Through this call – barangay officials were reminded that libraries are part of the community that serves information and knowledge both in print and electronic readily available to clients. Also, it helps and provide support in literacy campaign by providing an appropriate reading materials to enhance the reading interest and develop the reading skills and comprehension of every individual. Thus, public libraries give support to education sector at all levels. With the goal of making Quezon City a “Reading City”, begins with us by encouraging every barangay to take an active participation through establishing a public library. In response to this call the barangay Holy Spirit and Bagong Silangan positively agreed to our call with action

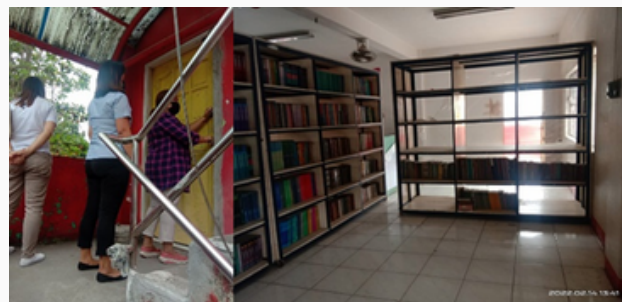

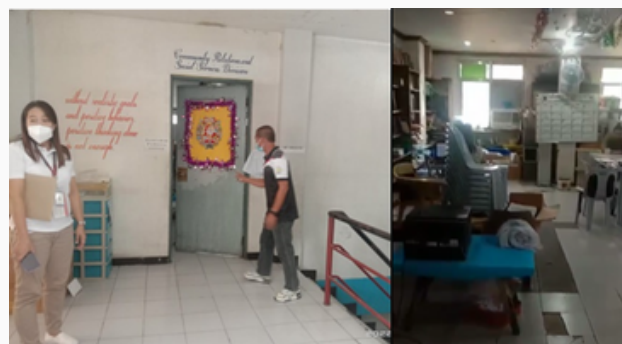

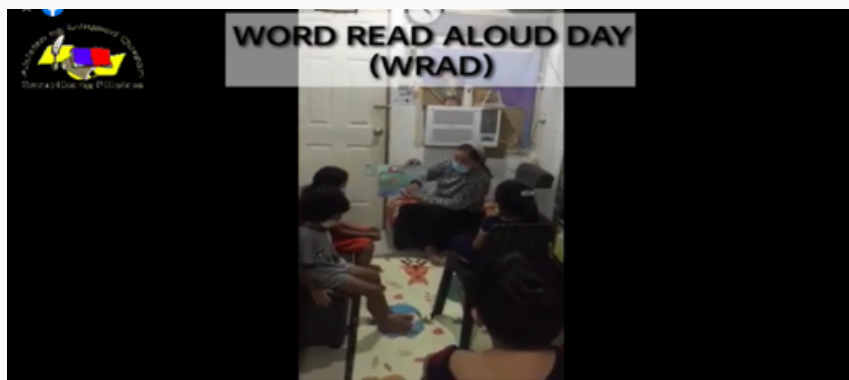

Pamilya sa Gitna ng Pandemya

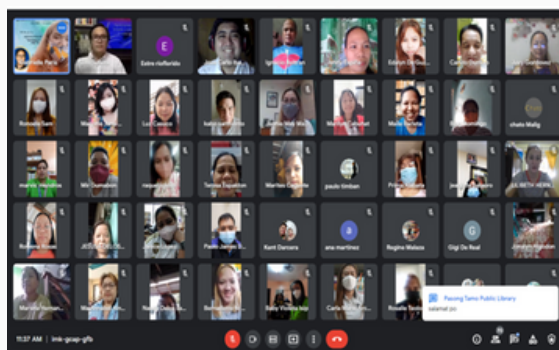

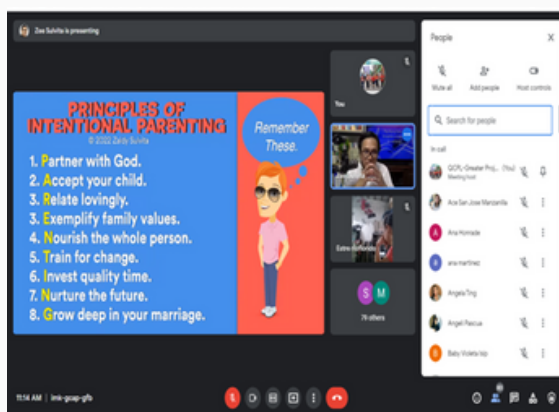

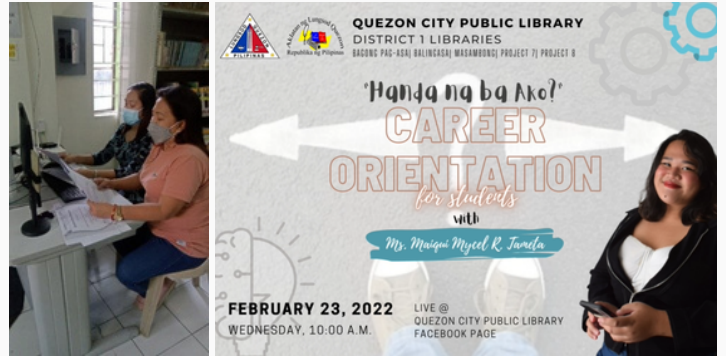
“HANDA NA BA AKO?”

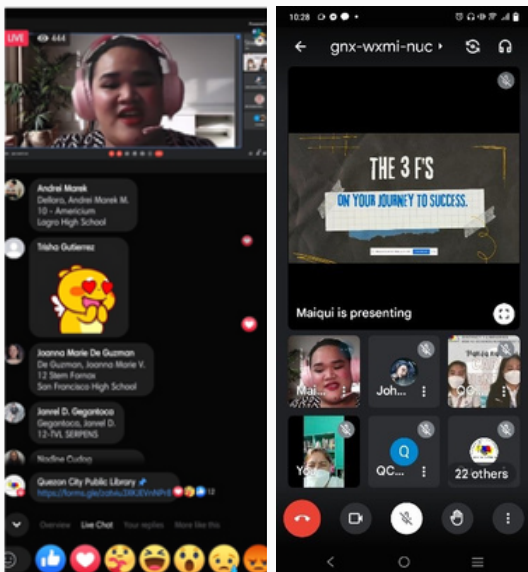

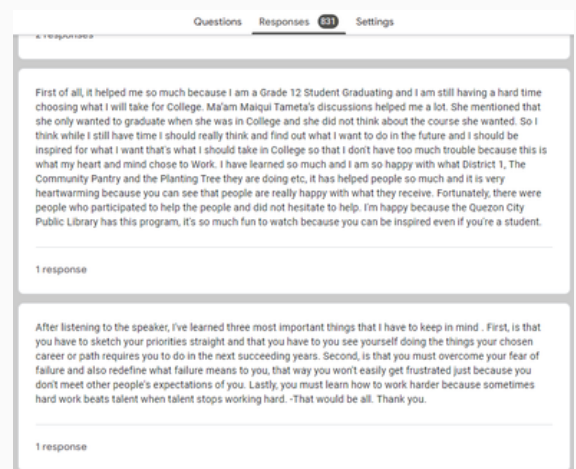

NOAH'S ARK

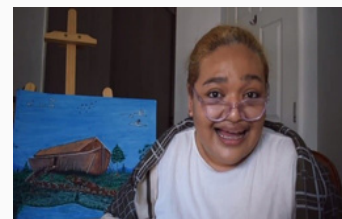

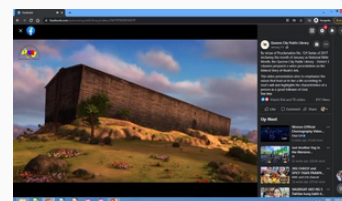
This video aims to emphasize the values that lead us to live a life according to God’s will and highlighted the characteristics of a person as a good follower of God.

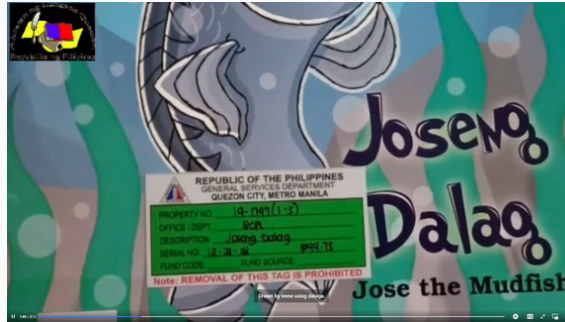

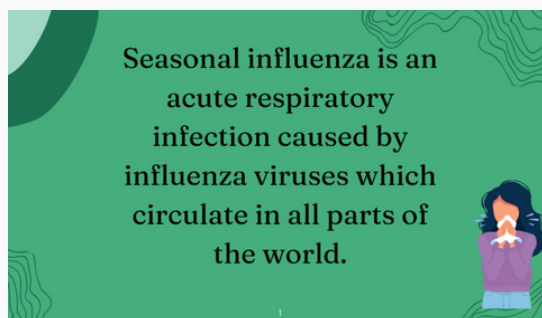

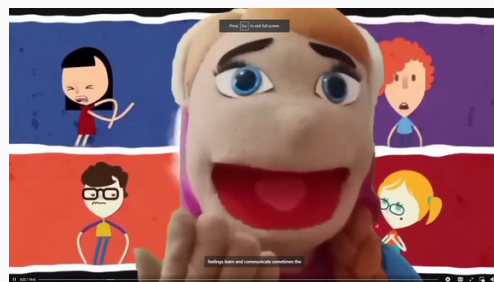


Book Impossible: Library in Action

The said orientation was attended by fifty-nine (59) participants representing the different QC departments, offices and QCPL branch libraries.

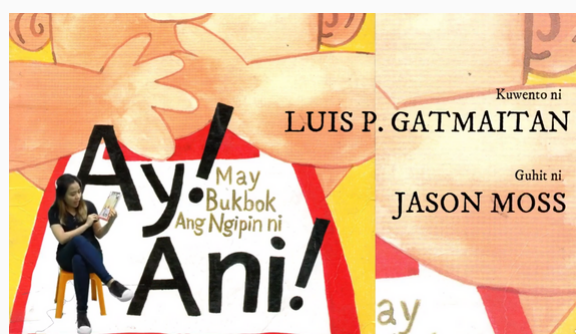

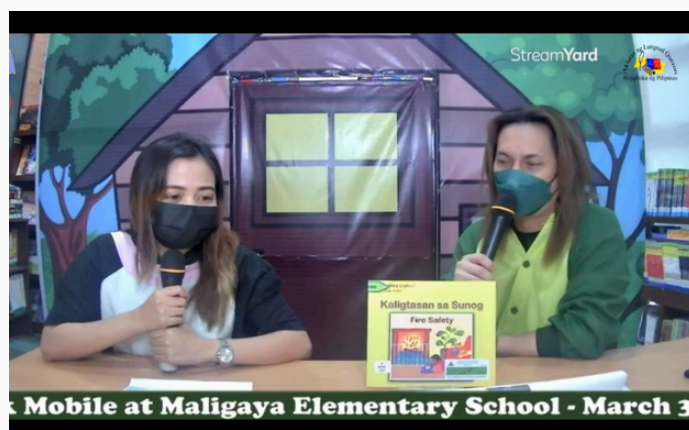

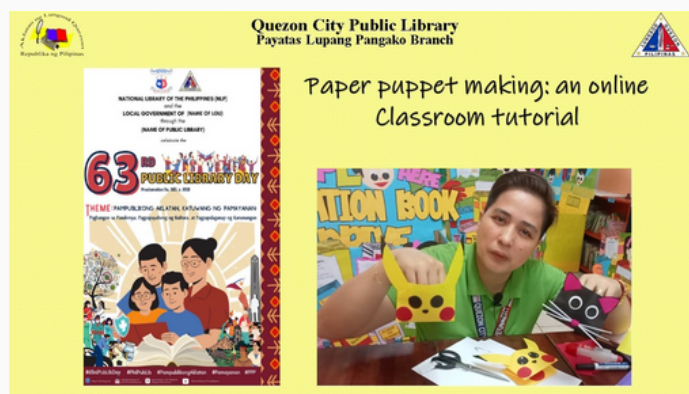
