ORDINANCE NO. SP-439, S-96

AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING BARANGAY PASONG PUTIK INTO THREE (3) BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY GREATER LAGRO, BARANGAY PASONG PUTIK PROPER AND BARANGAY NORTH FAIRVIEW, AND ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE SPECIAL PROJECTS FUNDS (BARANGAY PLEBISCITE) UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE VICE MAYOR APPROPRIATED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II, WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, MA. FRESCA M. BIGLANG-AWA, MARCIANO P. MEDALLA, ANTONIO V. HERNANDEZ (Anthony Alonzo) and ENRICO S. SERRANO.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides, among other things, that "a local government unit may be created, divided, merged, abolished, or its boundaries substantially altered either by law enacted by Congress in the case of a province, city, municipality, or any other political subdivision, or by ordinance passed by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan or Sangguniang Panlungsod concerned in the case of barangay located within its territorial jurisdiction, subject to such limitations and requirements prescribe in this code";

WHEREAS, on March 9, 1995, the Quezon City Council enacted proposed ordinance (PO94-09), which seek to divide Barangay Pasong Putik into three (3) barangays namely, Barangays Pasong Putik I, Pasong Putik II and Pasong Putik III, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING BARANGAY PASONG PUTIK INTO THREE (3) INDEPENDENT AND SEPARATE BARANGAYS TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAYS PASONG PUTIK I, PASONG PUTIK II, AND PASONG PUTIK III AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR."

WHEREAS, the said enacted ordinance (PO94-09) was not forwarded to the City Mayor, Honorable Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., for his honor's signature due to the fact that the then Presiding Officer of the City Council, Vice Mayor Charito L. Planas, did not sign the said measure on the ground that said ordinance did not specifically provide the amount in Section 4 thereof;



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WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council of Quezon City to push thru with the creation of three (3) barangays out of the existing Barangay Pasong Putik which will result into a more manageable smaller barangays thereby enhancing the delivery of basic services to the residents thereat;

WHEREAS, as per certification issued by the National Statistics Office (NSO) based on the 1995 Census of Population (POPCEN) conducted by the said office in September 1995, the mother barangay, Barangay Pasong Putik has a population of 42,203, and the three (3) proposed barangays, Barangay Greater Lagro (Pasong Putik I), Barangay Pasong Putik Proper (Pasong Putik II) and Barangay North Fairview (Pasong Putik III), has a population of 17,995, 14,728 and 9,480, respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Barangay Pasong Putik is hereby divided into three (3) barangays to be known as Barangay Greater Lagro, Barangay Pasong Putik Proper and Barangay North Fairview.

SECTION 2. The territorial jurisdiction of the barangays created under the preceding section are hereby identified as follows:

- A. Barangay Greater Lagro shall cover the areas of Lagro Subdivision, Hilltop Subdivision, La Mesa Dam Homesite, Neopolitan - Sitio Milan, and MWSS Housing Project.
- B. Barangay Pasong Putik Proper shall cover the areas of Teresa Heights, Maligaya Village, Sacred Heart Village and Neopolitan - Sitio Britany.
- C. Barangay North Fairview shall cover the areas of North Fairview, Fairmont, Neopolitan - Sitio Soville and SSS Village.

SECTION 3. The boundaries (metes and bounds) of the three (3) barangays created under Section 1 hereof is hereby delineated as follows:

BARANGAY GREATER LAGRO

North = Quirino Highway
East = MWSS Reservoir
West = Belfast St., andando Avc., Bgy. Sta. Monica and Bgy. Pasong Putik Boundary
South = Creek; D.B.T. Marbay/Lagro Subd., Boundary

BARANGAY PASONG PUTIK PROPER

- North = Kalookan/Quezon City Boundary
- East = Belfast St., Kalookan and Quezon City Boundary
- West = Kaligayahan/New Haven and Teresa Heights Boundary
- South = Quirino Highway, Mindanao Avenue

BARANGAY NORTH FAIRVIEW

- North = Creek, D.B.T. Marbay and Lagro Subd., Boundaries
- East = Lagro Subd., Tullahan Creek
- West = Bgy. Sta. Monica and North Fairview Subd., Boundary
- South = Bgy. Fairview/Tullahan Creek

The official map of the above-mentioned barangays as prepared by the City Assessor's Office, delineating the areas respectively covered by the said three (3) barangays, are hereby attached and made integral parts of this Ordinance, marked as Annexes "A", "B" and "C", respectively.

SECTION 4. The personnel performing as technical working group for the splitting of Barangay Pasong Putik since July 1996 is hereby formally constituted as a Committee composed of the following:

 - = Two (2) representatives from the Office of Coun. Godofredo T. Liban II.
 - = One (1) representative from the Office of the City Treasurer
 - = One (1) representative from the Barangay Operations Center (BOC)
 - = One (1) representative from the Commission on Election (COMELEC)
 - = Two (2) representatives from the National Statistics Office (NSO)
 - = One (1) representative from the City Assessor's Office

Support Staff:
= Two (2) utility personnel from the Office of the City Secretary

The foregoing chairman, members and staff are hereby entitled to receive an honorarium.

SECTION 5. A plebiscite for this purpose shall be conducted not later than 120 days after approval of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. There is hereby allocated the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P500,000.00) to be taken from the Special Projects Funds (Barangay Plebiscite) under the Office of the Vice Mayor appropriated in the 1996 Annual Budget of Quezon City to pay for all expenses in the holding of the plebiscite and all other expenses that will be incurred in connection with this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
