

ORDINANCE Numbered 175

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REVERSION OF ₱46,000.00 FROM THE SUNDRY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (Ca-64) AND ₱13,000.00 FROM UNDERESTIMATED REVENUE (Ca-8, Ca-9, Ca-14, & Ca-39), ACTUALLY COLLECTED; AND APPROPRIATING SUCH AMOUNTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COURT HOUSE AND JAIL (C-61(6) - ₱40,000.00; and ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW CITY HALL (C-61(1) - ₱10,000.00; AND TRANSFER TO HEALTH CENTER FUND (C-53(5) - ₱9,000.00

WHEREAS, the New Quezon City Hall at Cubao, which will soon be finished, has no place for the Municipal Court and has no annexed or separate building for the City Jail;

WHEREAS, the necessity of a City Jail, designed for the purpose, is extremely felt nowadays when the number of persons detained or imprisoned for minor offenses or petty crimes ranges from thirty to forty seven at a time;

WHEREAS, these detainees or prisoners, men and women alike, are presently crowded and huddled together in a crudely constructed temporary enclosure within the Diliman Market Building which in point of health, safekeeping and morality is dangerous and unsafe; and

WHEREAS, the plan for Economic Agricultural Development of Quezon City, though important, is not so vital and urgent compared with the necessity of an appropriate City Jail - that the former can be deferred to give way to the latter without any detriment to public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1.- The reversion of forty six thousand pesos (₱46,000.00) from the Sundry Economic Development (Ca-64) and thirteen thousand pesos (₱13,000.00) from Underestimated Revenue (Ca-8, Ca-9, Ca-14, & Ca-39), actually collected, are hereby authorized.

SECTION 2.- The sum of fifty nine thousand pesos (₱59,000.00) reverted in Section 1 hereof, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to be made available as follows:

Construction of Court House and Jail - - -	₱40,000.00
Additional appropriation for the construction of the New City Hall- - - - -	10,000.00
Transfer to Health Center Fund - - - - -	9,000.00

SECTION 3.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
