GRANTING AMNESTY UP TO DECEMBER 31, 1972 TO PERSONS WHO HAVE  
TATTOOS AND WHO ARE WILLING TO HAVE THEM REMOVED, PROVIDED  
THAT THEY HAVE NO CRIMINAL RECORD AND/OR PENDING CRIMINAL  
CASE.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City in  
session assembled:

SECTION 1. Persons who have tattoos and who are willing  
to have them removed, are hereby granted an amnesty up to  
December 31, 1972; PROVIDED, that this Ordinance shall apply  
only to persons with tattoo who have no criminal record and/  
no pending criminal case.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its  
approval.
