City Librarian's Corner

(A message delivered during the flag raising ceremony)



Reading is very important, it helps us discover the world, not only our world here but also even foreign lands. Reading develops our imagination and creativity. It improves our vocabulary and communication skills. Reading makes us dream and strive for a better life. Without reading, we may not know what is wrong or right. Sometimes, we become victims of fake news and disinformation. The good news here is – There is no fake news inside the library since it is a repository of actual knowledge and accurate information printed in books, journals, encyclopedias, and periodicals

During the pandemic, we all know that technology has impacted our lives, even our reading habits. According to a lot of scientific research, reading on paper provides better concentration, learning, and remembering compared to reading on a gadget screen. Sabi nga ng mga nakatatanda at mga dalubhasa, iba pa rin ang pakiramdam ng mismong nakahawak sa papel ng isang libro o aklat. But we have to accept that using technology is now a must, more so in public libraries. A challenge library now must face: How to provide better library services to our constituents in this new normal.

This is the reason why the QCPL continues to intensify its efforts to promote reading for all, especially the QCitizen youth. During the pandemic, we made sure to use technology to reach out. We conducted numerous online reading tutorials, storytelling and other activities via Zoom and through social media, so that students can watch and learn at the comfort of their homes. To make these online readings more entertaining for the kids, we used the wonder of puppets and other innovative and creative storytelling designs and techniques. According to our latest data, our online activities posted in our official FB page has a total of 54,947 shares, 85,645 Likes and 6,151 comments from 2021 to the 2nd quarter of this year.

In our mission to make Quezon City a Reading City, we continue to establish mini libraries in different barangays in consonance with RA 7743, City Resolution No. SP-6107, S-2014, City Resolution No. SP-7950, S-2019, all for the establishment of mini-libraries and barangay reading centers in Quezon City. In fact, we are now organizing two (2) branch libraries, which are soon to be opened located at barangays Tagumpay in District 3 and Barangay Culiati in District 6. From the existing 17 branches, we will now have 19 branch libraries. Still far from the total number of 142 barangays in the city.

We continue to seek partnership with government agencies and private entities for the establishment of more branch libraries to be located in the different congressional districts of our City. If it is not so much to ask and propose to our Honorable Congressmen to allot a space for a reading center/mini library to soon to be constructed multi-purpose halls. For those barangays with no established libraries, we utilized our bookmobiles or mobile libraries to reach out to these barangays to provide the informational, educational and recreational needs of the city constituents.

Quezon City has more than 3 million population, and it is a great challenge on the part of the QCPL to have a total book collection equal to the city populace to make sure that all QCitizens will have access to books and other reading materials. With this challenge, we are strengthening our Book Donation Drive partnering with various organizations, publishers and establishments, with the theme: "Share a Book and Help Feed the Minds of Every QCitizen". Recently, we have partnered with Walter Mart regarding our project on Book Donation Drive and we have also come up with conducting activities in celebration of National Children's Book Month this July 16, 2022 and other celebration for the month of August and September this year with the theme "QCPL Book Donation Drive: Dazzling Family Day with JOY at Walter Mart's activity area in Muñoz (North EDSA branch).

As we continue to adapt to this new normal, the QCPL continues to thrive and innovate. Walang maiiwanang mangmang sa Quezon City because we will be relentless in our mission to bring the value of reading, learning and researching to all. We hope that there will come a time that the three million (3M) QCitizens are reading Citizens too. And all these activities have been recognized and honored by the National Library of the Philippines, awarding our Quezon City Public Library – Lagro Branch as the 2021 Top Performing Public Library in the Philippines Awardee – Barangay Reading Center/Branch Category.

On behalf of all the team members of the QCPL, we want to convey our appreciation for all the support of our Honorable Mayor Joy Belmonte, Vice Mayor Gian Sotto, our City Councilors, and all the different departments of the City.

Getting Acquainted: Webinar on QCPL's e-Resources By Readers' Services Division

The Quezon City Public Library thru its Readers' Services Division hosted a webinar entitled "Orientation on the Use of QCPL E-Resources" on May 24, 2022. Educators including teachers, librarians, and learning resource coordinators from the Division of Quezon City Schools and Quezon City University Library were among the participants in this online event. This webinar was initiated and conducted by RSD librarians and staff to encourage the participants and members of the academic communities to make use of the QCPL's e-resources and to provide a venue of promoting strong linkages to public schools, as well as private schools, colleges and universities in Quezon City.

Ms. Mary Ann Bernal, Head of the Readers' Services Division, gave her warm "Welcome Remarks" and briefly talked on the aims and objectives of conducting the orientation and sharing of the QCPL's e-resources.

Ms. Mariza Chico, OIC City Librarian, delivered her Inspirational Message, thanking everyone for their participation in the webinar. She discussed the "importance of right information these days as there is a worldwide challenge of proliferation of misinformation and disinformation online." She also thanked the Readers Services Division for boosting the collaboration and partnership with the Quezon City Schools and Quezon City University.

The invited resource speakers talked on their individual “line of expertise” presenting and discussing in detail the special features of their respective organizations giving emphasis in the area of accessibility. Mr. Francis L. Tanghal presented the key features and components of the 3G Smart Online Library, a leading independent publisher specializing in developing collections of titles in various subject areas. Subsequently, Mr. Jerome Palermo, thoroughly discussed the dynamics of WorldBook Online emphasizing on its tons of encyclopedia articles and many other great reference tools for early learners through senior high school as well as for educators. Afterwards, Mr. Jericho Tumibay talked about PressReader, an online database offering an array of 1000 publications of local and global news from the world’s most reputable journalists and sources. Lastly, the QCPL’s very own, Mr. Paulo Dominik Daulat, Filipiniana Section Head, introduced Quezon City Library Repository Online System (QCLibros), a digital space developed by QCPL, where digitized collections of the Filipiniana, Periodicals, and Law Research Sections are uploaded. At the end of each presentation, an open forum/discussion was conducted wherein the resource speakers accommodated and answered queries and concerns from the participants.



The Closing Remarks was given by Ms. Lucila Raquino, OIC, Asst. City Librarian, thanking everyone – the resource speakers, the 136 participants, the QCPL’s librarians and staff for their concerted efforts, cooperation and invaluable support.

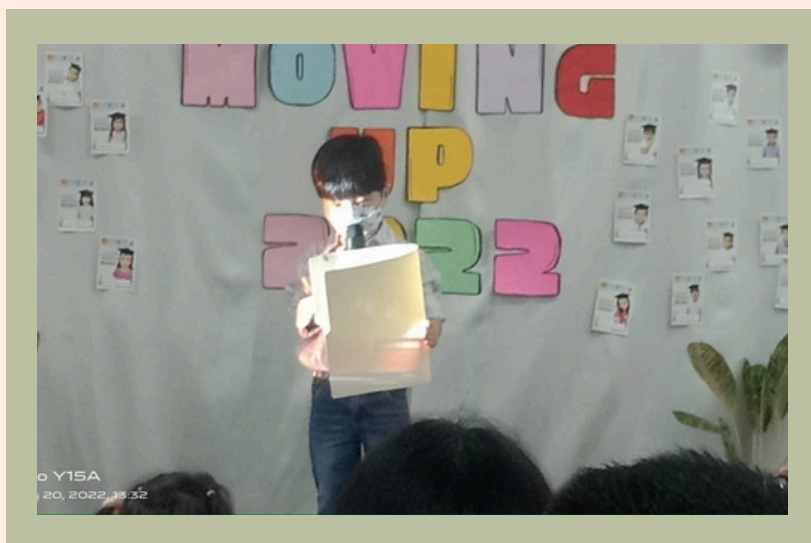

"SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE EFFECTIVE PREPARATION OF REPORTS AND INVENTORY OF LIBRARY MATERIALS"

The District Libraries Division conducted a face-to-face orientation to staff of the Quezon City Public Library from the main and branch libraries entitled "Seminar-Workshop on the Effective Preparation of Reports and Inventory of Library Materials" on April 27, 2022 at the QCPL Main Conference Room.

The objectives of the seminar-workshop were to learn how adapt to the new policies set by the Inventory Team, to explain the process of transferring books and equipment, submission of reports from branch libraries to NLP, and learn some strategies on how to increase the number of library users/clients. This activity also aimed to focus on how to monitor Google sheet and the use of Gmail as an effective tool of communication.

The seminar started with an Opening Remarks delivered by Ms. Analiza C. Martinez, Head of District Libraries Division, followed by the Inspirational Messages of Ms. Mariza G. Chico, OIC- City Librarian, and Ms. Lucila R. Raquiño, OIC-Assistant City Librarian. The first topic was facilitated by Ms. Ma. Regina S. Malaza, Staff from the Inventory Unit, wherein she discussed the "Inventory Policies and Other Matters" pertaining to the process of inventory.

Mr. Jan Angelo Jasareno, staff of MIS, talked about "NLP Reports" and explained to the participants the proper format of preparing the reports for submission to the National Library of the Philippines. Several questions were raised during the discussion which were answered fully by our speaker.

Ms. Analiza C. Martinez, Head of District Libraries Division, discussed the "Strategies on how to Increase the Number of Library Users and Collections." She elaborated this topic to help our branch libraries staff to utilized their skills and expertise to attract prospective users/clients and increase the number of library users despite the new normal situation and the growth of technologies.

In the afternoon session, Mr. Edgel Cedrick Esteban, Administrative Aide, discussed the topic on Monitoring Google sheet and explained how to check/monitor the incoming or outgoing communication. He also explained to the participants the proper raw files to be submitted.

The last speaker for the afternoon session, Ms. Rona D. Crucillo, Assistant Head of the District Libraries Division, talked on the topic "Gmail as an Effective Communication Tool". She started the discussion with a game to lighten up the mood of the participants. She discussed the topic on how to send and received an email encouraged the branch libraries staff to use Gmail for faster communication. She also explained to the participants the importance of double checking of Gmail.

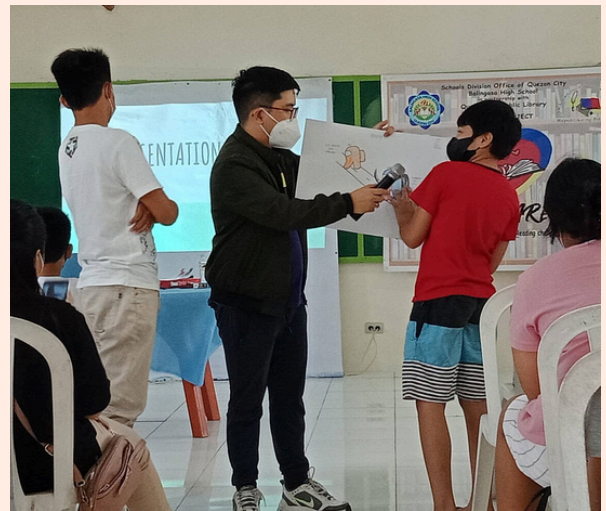

"Mga Lugar na Pamana sa Lungsod ng Quezon?"

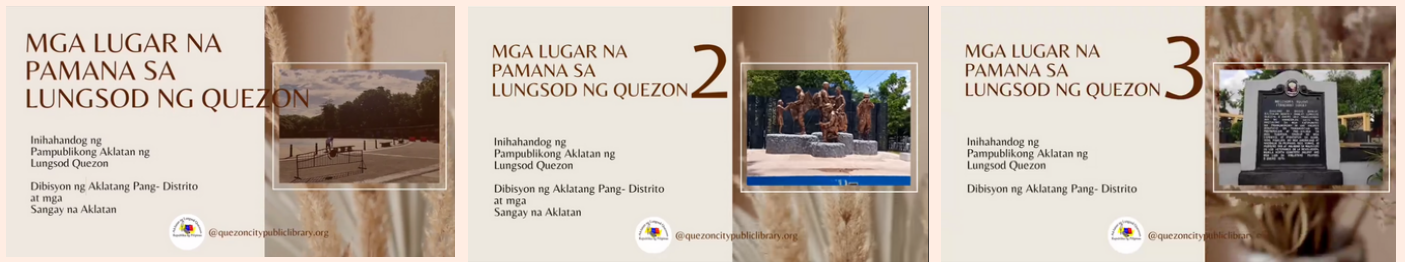

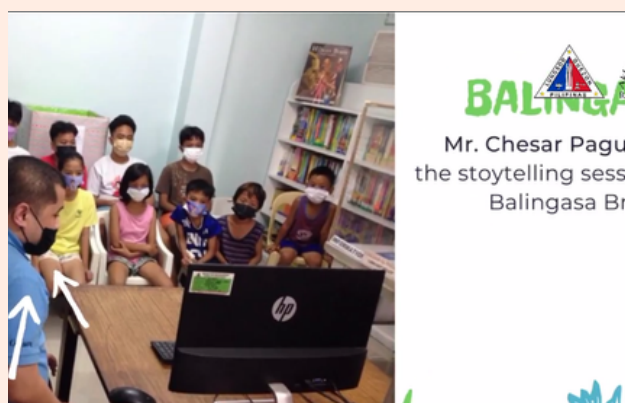
