(QCPADFI), a non-stock corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, is a leading Performing Arts Foundation dedicated to nurturing and promoting the performing arts in all its diverse forms;

WHEREAS, the QCPADFI is home to underprivileged children whose hearts and spirits are set free in the world of dance and music. Since its establishment in 2001, QCPADFI has become a haven to more than 4,000 scholars who have discovered the power to express themselves in a language that goes beyond words;

WHEREAS, QCPADFI is also a Civil Society Organization accredited by the 22nd Quezon City Council under Ordinance No. SP-3137, S-2022;

WHEREAS, aside from its previous awards, the QCPADFI brought home in 2023 two Golden Diplomas in the categories of Musica Contemporanca Mixed Voices and Mixed Youth Choirs at the 12th World Choir Games in Gangneung, South Korea. Hence, QCPADFI became qualified to join the Champions Competition;

WHEREAS, the QCPADFI is joining the World Choir Games 2024 in Auckland, New Zealand on July 15 to 21, 2024. QCPADFI will compete in the Mixed Chamber Choirs category and the Sacred Choral Music category. Its concert chorus will also participate in free concerts and MasterClasses organized by Interkultur in Auckland;

WHEREAS, the group was also invited to do a collaborative concert in New Zealand by one of the choral groups from the United States of America. It is also arranging a live performance to showcase the talents of the Quezon City youth for the Filipino communities in Auckland;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes and believes that joining international competitions and performing with other talented groups from other countries will help the QCPADFI achieve its goal to be a globally-recognized performing arts institution, empowering the City's youth who are proud of their identity and heritage;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government is willing to support the QCPADFI by extending financial assistance of Php5,869,520.00 to the upcoming World Choir Games 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to grant financial assistance of Php5,869,520.00 to the Quezon City Performing Arts Development Foundation, Inc. for the World Choir Games 2024 in Auckland, New Zealand.
