ORDINANCE NO. 8269, S-70

ORDINANCE

PROVIDING THAT ANY JEEP PURCHASED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXCLUSIVE BENEFIT OF THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT BE USED OR ALLOWED TO OPERATE OUTSIDE ITS ASSIGNED PRECINCT SECTOR, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE IN CERTAIN EXCEPTIONAL CASES, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, for public interest and efficiency of service, the maximum use of police vehicles shall at least be confined to its assigned sector of operation;  
Now, therefore, be it

Ordnained by the Council of Quezon City  
in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Any jeep purchased or acquired by the city government for the exclusive benefit of the Quezon City Police Department shall not be used or allowed to operate outside its assigned precinct sector, unless authorized by the Chief of Police in certain exceptional cases.

SEC. 2. Violation of this Ordinance shall be penalized by forfeiture of the violators two (2) months salary.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
