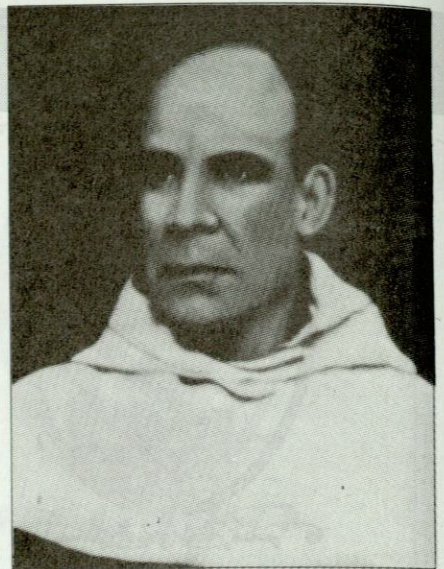
HISTORY AND GROWTH OF MATER CARMELI SCHOOL

How did Mater Carmeli School begin and expand?

MATER Carmeli School is administered by the Carmelite Missionaries, a congregation of women founded in may 1860 in Barcelona Spain through a unique experience of the mystery of the Church by the Discalced Carmelite, Father Francisco Palau y Quer. Father Palau was beatified by Pope John Paul II on April 24, 1988. At present, there are 2,000 Carmelite Missionaries of different nationalities spread all over North and South America, Africa, Asia and Europe. These zealous daughters of Blessed Francisco Palau have widened their nets in 30 countries to answer the call and the challenge to go "Ad Gentes", to share the Good News to other nations. They bring the message of hope and love to the world of today through: Christian education, health care, socio-pastoral work, campus and youth ministry, guidance and counseling, promotion of spiritual life, care of children and the handicapped, catechesis and missions.

The Carmelite Missionaries came to the Philippines in 1956 to expand their apostolate starting in Iloilo. In the summer of 1960, they took control of St. Joseph Kindergarten School located at 272 D. Tuazon Avenue, Quezon City. At that time, the school was administered by a group of catechists under Sr. Fatima and supported by Mrs. Mariquit Lopez, wife of former Vice-President Fernando Lopez. Civic-minded members of the community helped the Carmelite Missionaries expand the Kindergarten school.

In line with its expansion program, a permit for the conversion of St. Joseph Kindergarten School to an elementary school was obtained through the assistance of Atty. Angelita Chipeco. Mr. Anselmo Aguilung, a civic leader in the community, initiated the solicitation of funds from generous benefactors of the school used in the construction of a one-storey building to provide for additional rooms.

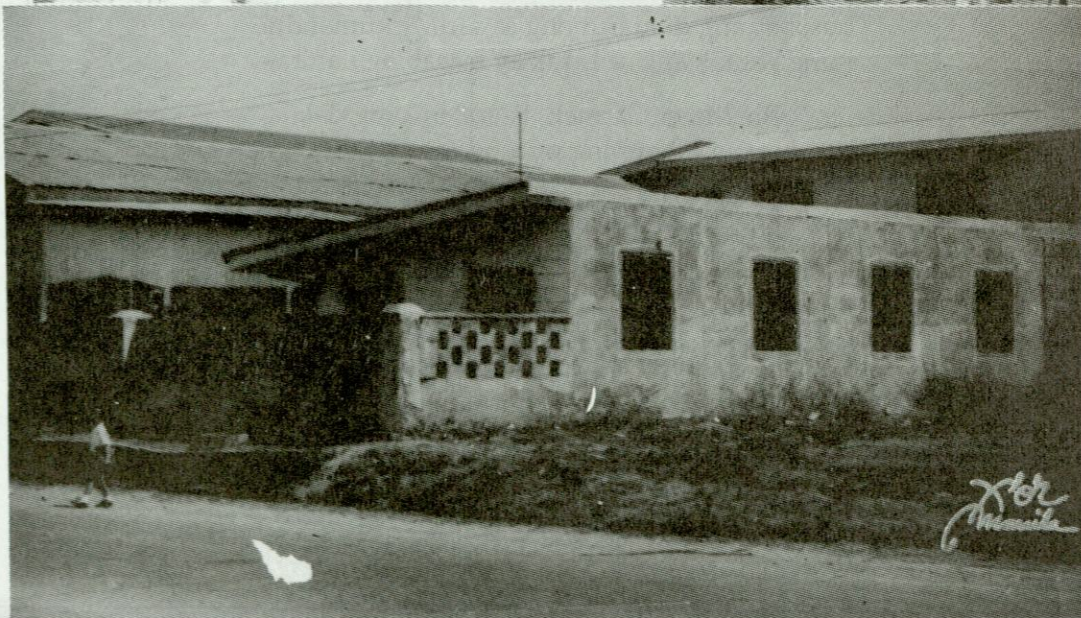

(1811-1872)

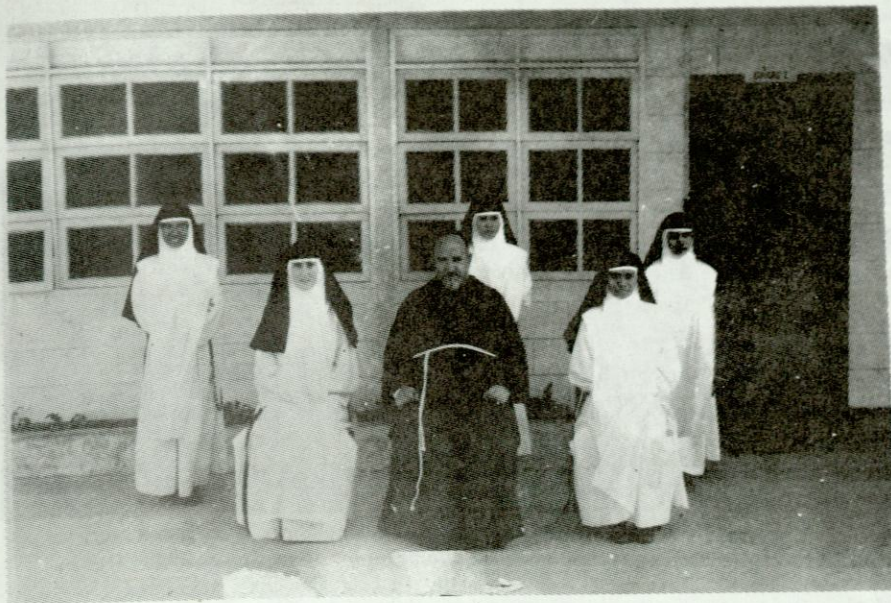

In June of 1960, a community of sisters was assigned to administer the school. Sr. Natividad Martinez Santamaria and Sr. Lourdes Antonio Andres were the first Directress and Principal respectively. The school began with forty-five pupils in kindergarten, eighteen in Grade I and seven in Grade II. In-charge of the kindergarten class was Sr. Lucy Antoja; that of the Grade I, Sr. Ma. Dolores Buot while that of the Gr. II, Sr. Antonio Andres.

On August 11, 1960, the Regional Superintendent, Department of Education approved the change of the school's name into "Escuela de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes". It gained Government Recognition No. 276 on June 12, 1961. By the school year 1962-63, Sr. Veronica Celine took over from Sr. Antonio as principal of the school. On the other hand, Sr. Aurora Prado Biurum who arrived from Spain, replaced Sr. Natividad as Directress from 1961-1968.

As the years moved along, the population of the school grew but some confusion regarding communication got into the picture. Lourdes School in Retiro Street, La Loma, Quezon City often got our calls and written communication, moreover, at times, people got the wrong direction: instead of going to Lourdes School, they came to us. It became imperative therefore for the Carmelite Missionaries to make a change. On April 2, 1964, the name of the school became MATER CARMELI SCHOOL.

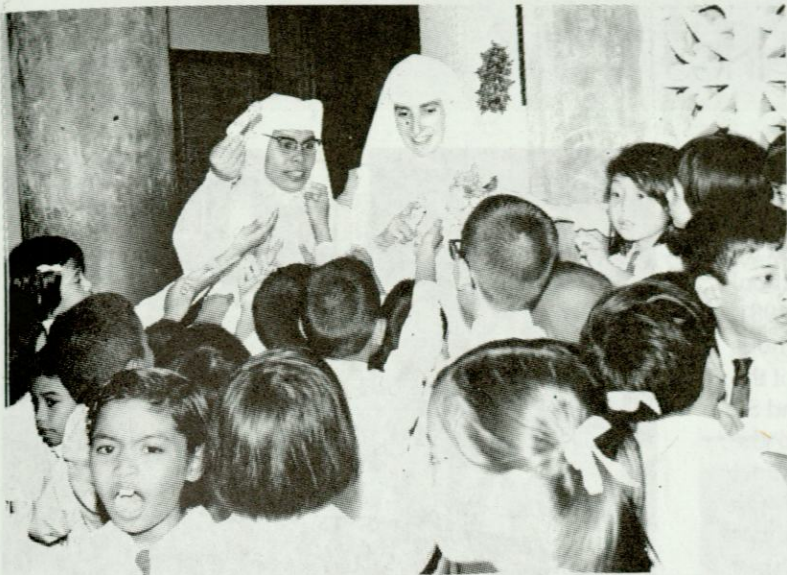

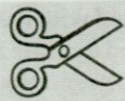
Faced with the pressing problem for more rooms due to expected increase in enrollment as it gained more support from the community, the school in October 1964 undertook an expansion of major facilities by converting the one-storey building into a four-storey one.

In 1965, Sr. Veronica Celine, the principal then, invited the parents to organize an association that would serve as a connecting link between the home and the school. On September 12, 1965, the Mater Carmeli School Parents' Teachers' Association (MCAPTA) was organized with its own Constitution and By-Laws with Mr. Marcelino Simbul as elected president. The association although it was running smoothly at the beginning was short-lived due to difficult times. It stopped functioning on May 25, 1967.

Sr. Lucy Antoja became the principal for school year 1968-1969 while Sr. Concepcion Arellano, Imas was appointed directress. This school year saw the start of the construction of the annex building which housed the school chapel and the kindergarten rooms. Appointed directress in 1970 was Sr. Aurora Tanaleon whose term expired three years after when the function of the Directress were integrated with those of the principal. By this time, Sr. Ma. Dolores Buot became the principal until she left for Rome for further studies in September 1973.

On September 12, 1971, an attempt to organize an advisory board to the school was materialized when the Parent-Teacher Encounter was held. The Board meant to serve as a medium between the school authorities and the parents regarding problems, ideas and other matters affecting the children and the school administration. Attorney Benigno Sabban, Jr. was elected Chairman. Times of trial did not daunt the parents to begin anew somehow to put together again what had been broken by tensions. It is often when a community is on the verge of breaking up that people agree to talk to each other and look at each other's eyes.

Sr. Antonia Andres was reassigned to Mater Carmeli School and reassumed the position of principal from October 1973 to school year 1977-1978. For the next two school years, Sr. Evelyn Tingson and Sr. Lydia Ramos were the principals.



CLIPPINGS!!!

DURING the school year 1979-1980, instead of the MCS Advisory Board, a Parents' Committee was organized with 13 members to represent the different grades and sections of the school with Mr. Hector Aguling as the Overall Chairman. In 1980-1981, the said Committee became the Ad-Hoc Committee. By unanimous choice, Mr. Aguling was re-elected Chairman. Before the end of the school year, Sr. Milagros Villanueva, former Vice Provincial and Sr. Lourdes Antonia Andres who for the third time reassumed the position of principal, advised Mr. Aguling to revive the defunct MCAPTA for the greater involvement of parents in school. On September 6, 1981, the Mater Carmeli School Parents Council was formally organized with Mr. Aguling as the President. The dynamic leadership of this parent with the active involvement of the Parents Council had greatly developed the parents' better understanding of their children's needs at home and in school. Harmonious relationship between the school and the parents was promoted and school facilities increased and progressed. The newsletter, *Tinig ng Carmeli* got published. This medium of dissemination of activities in the school which was initiated by Mr. Aguling and now published by the pupils of MCS enhanced and developed to a great extent the communication skills of the Carmelians. Mr. Aguling was the MCSPC president for six consecutive terms: school years 1981-1982 to 1984-1987.

PARENTS' COUNCIL HOLDS SEMINAR

Third and last of the series of seminars undertaken by the Parents' Council for the school year 1986. The series of events that were held after the Snap Elections, prolonged disruptions of classes due to the uncertainties of the situation then, made it almost impossible for the Committee on Parents' Development to plan on any activities for the parents. However, those few days in February 23, when people of all walks of life congregated along the EDSA to forestall any destruction of life and manifested what is now known as "People Power". That euphoria of the hope that it would

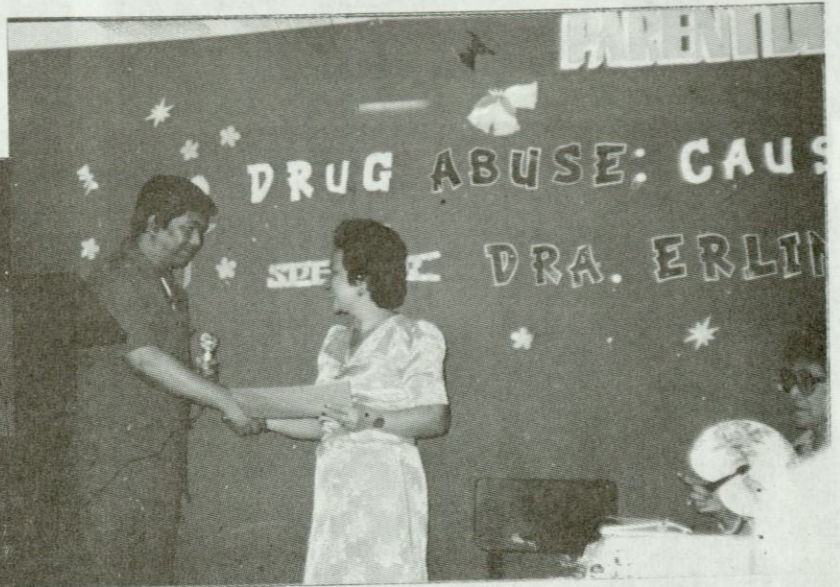

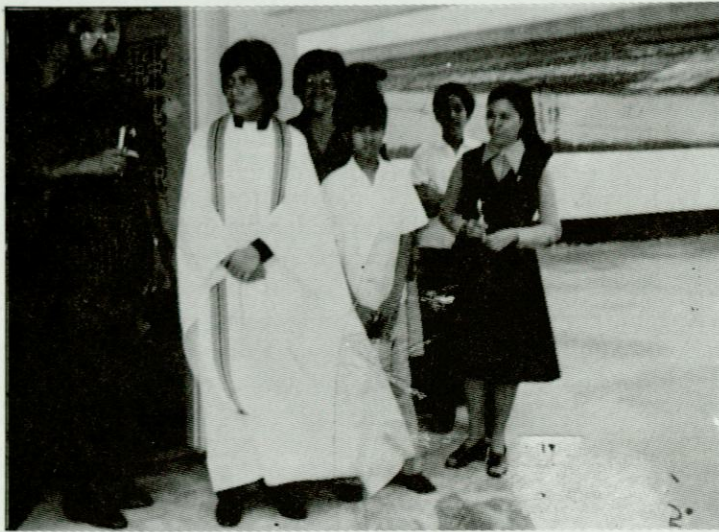

THE MULTI-PURPOSE SOCIAL HALL

In the succeeding years of its mission to Catholic education, Mater Carmeli School stimulated the confidence of the community due to the understanding of the school's program and the quality of instruction that MCS delivers. An upward shift became visible. More and more parents entrusted the education of their children to the school; consequently in 1981, the school expanded the annex building by adding another floor where the multi-purpose (room) hall, guidance room and the Parents Council Room are situated. It was in this year that Sr. Antonia Andres, for the third time, was reassigned to Mater Carmeli School as principal, a mission which she would undertake until 1988.



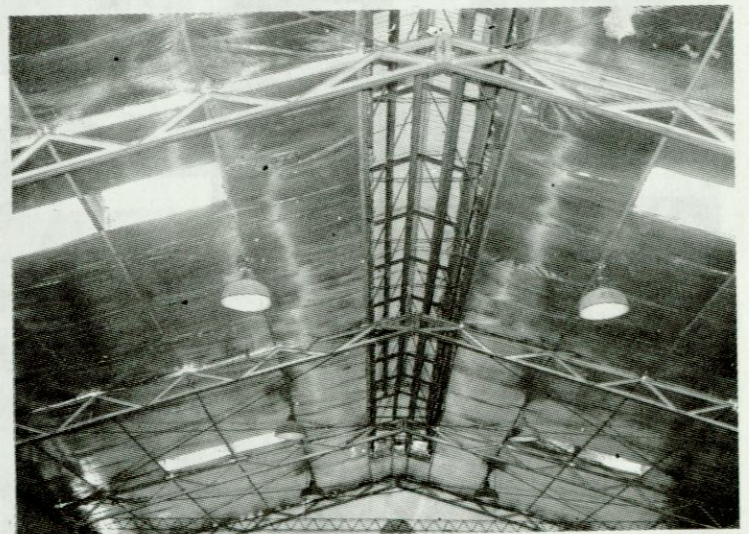

To ease the then congested lobby of the school which served as the venue of school's activities, the Sisters demolished their house in Summer 1989 and constructed a multi-purpose covered court aided by the active Parents Council. Finished and blessed in October 1989 by Fr. Benito Villalba, the school's chaplain for 17 years, the covered court became a gym, a social hall, a venue for school's major co-Curricular activities and graduation programs. Alongside with this innovation, were the new library, the principal's office and the faculty room.

Sr. Petronila Lalic took over from Sr. Antonia Andres as principal from school year 1988-89 to school year 1994-95.

It was a time of uncertainty and crisis for Mater Carmeli School at the beginning of the 90's when it faced the danger of being closed down. Sr. Ma. Jesus Zabalsa, Sister General of the Carmelite Missionaries, in her visit to the community saw the congestion in the school due to the rise of tall buildings of the nearby paint factory and felt that the vicinity is a fire hazard and cause of chemical pollution, hence, she advised the Sisters to inform the parents of the probable phase out of the school. The Administration conducted a survey of the feedback from parents about this matter. The Provincial Counsellors visited personally the management of the paint factory. The parents reacted adversely toward this move saying that many students would be displaced; MCS is a high standard school and they could not afford to lose it; their children receive Christian education at reasonable and affordable tuition fee; parents and the administration with the teachers have cordial relationships; and the school is accessible to many pupils. The Community made a position paper and the Parents Council made an audience with Sr. Eva Julia Estoque, Councilor General when she came over in 1994. Learning from the community that the paint factory has employed high tech gadget that prevents chemical pollution and considering the petition of the parents, the General Council gave its nod to keep Mater Carmeli going.

This school year marks the Coral Anniversary of Mater Carmeli. Sr. Teresita Sindac, Superior of the school community and Christian Living Coordinator is the acting principal until Sr. Ma. Gertita Tacuyan completes her research study at De La Salle University this October and takes over.

Each one imbued with a great vision and doing purposefully her share brought Mater Carmeli School to a place of prominence, to a vanguard of quality instruction and to an effective involvement in community building.

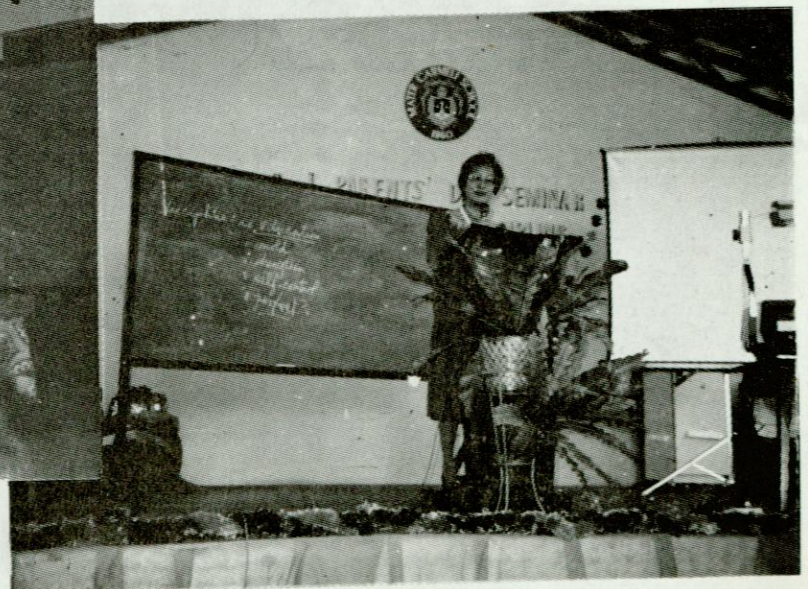
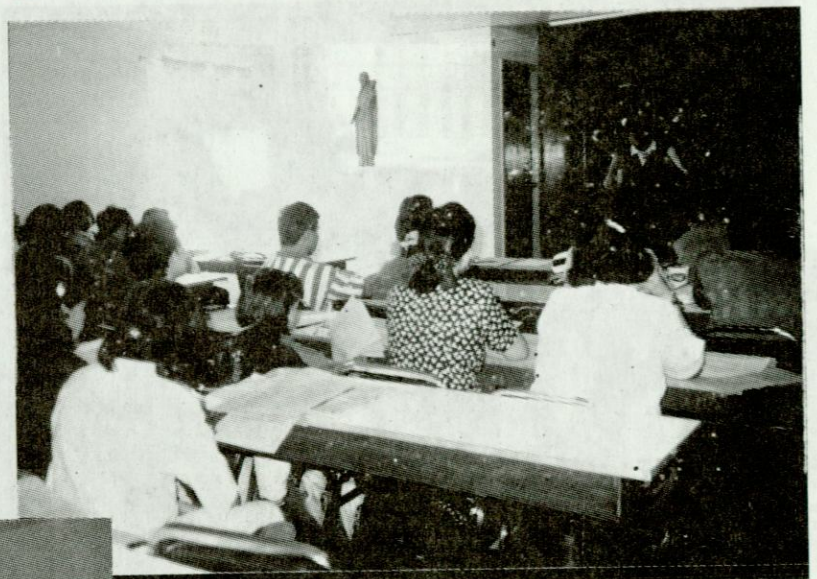

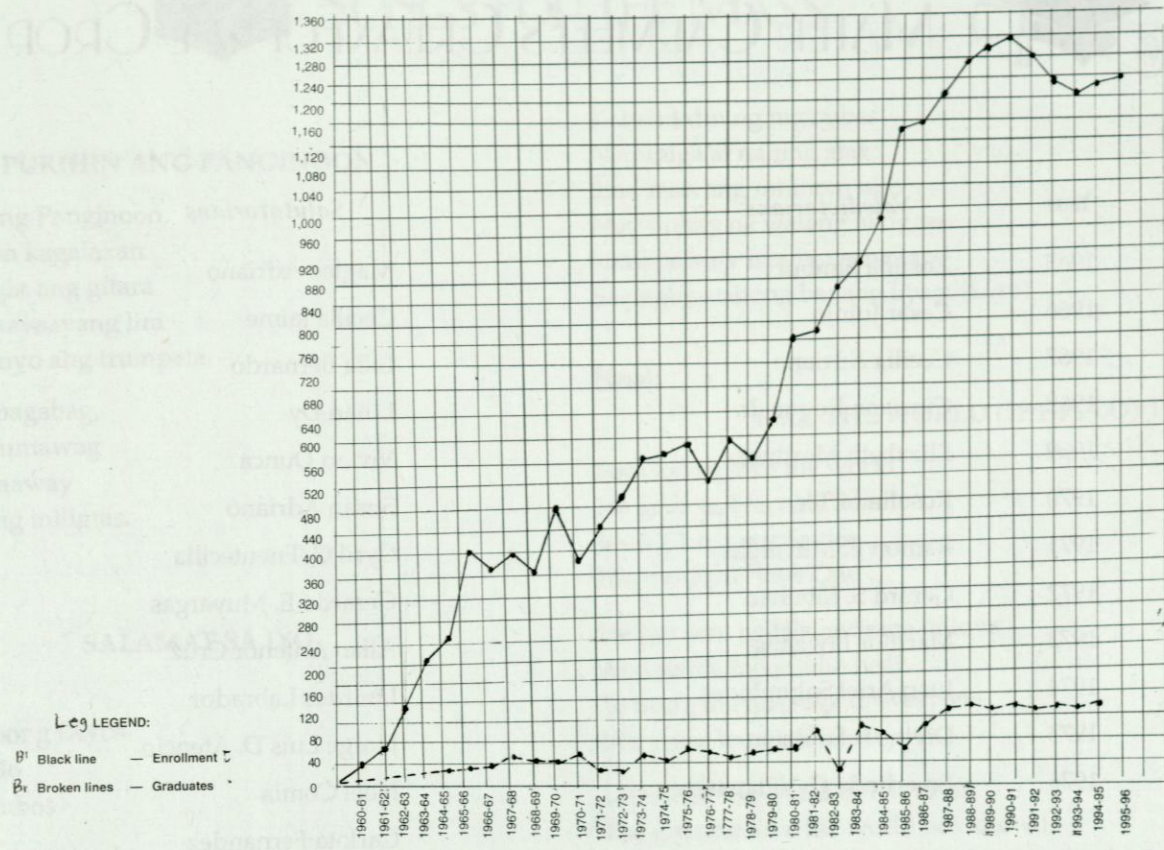
MA^TE^R Carmeli School has been building our educational community for 35 years!

 Broken lines — Graduates

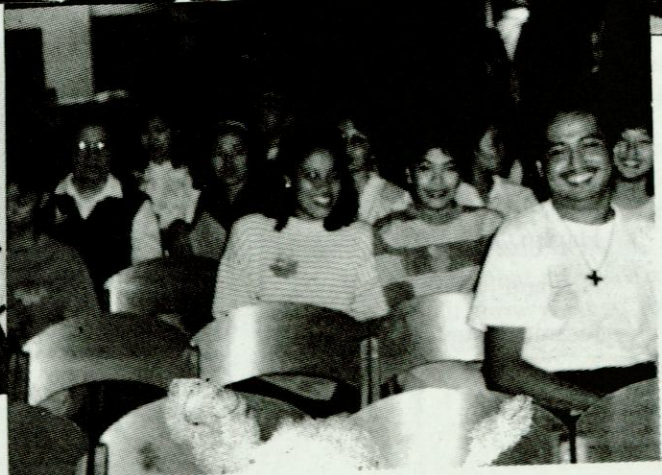

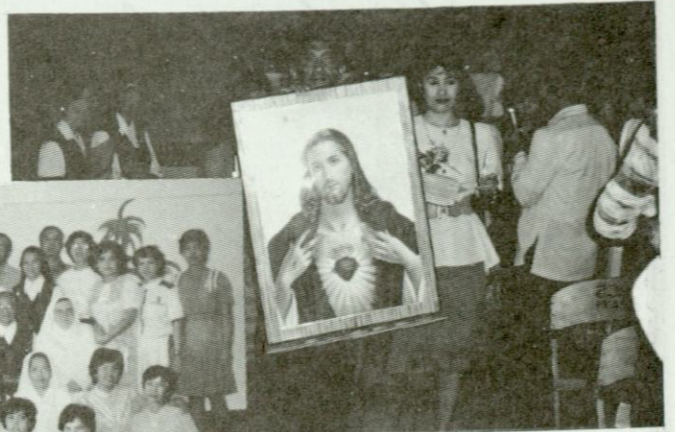
