RESOLUTION NO. SP- 10402, S-2026

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF EASY E-BINGO, INCORPORATED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC BINGO (E-BINGO) STATION AT LOWER GROUND FLOOR, 1123 NOVALICHES PLAZA MALL, QUIRINO HIGHWAY CORNER RAMIREZ, BARANGAY NOVALICHES PROPER, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, Easy E-Bingo Incorporated is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, with business address at Lower Ground Floor, 1123 Novaliches Plaza Mall, Quirino Highway corner Ramirez, Barangay Novaliches Proper, District V, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same business through Resolution No. SP-9303, S-2023 and amended by Resolution No. SP-9542, S-2023;



WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City ordinance;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned business activity will provide employment and additional revenue to the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Easy E-Bingo Incorporated to operate an Electronic Bingo (E-Bingo) Station at Lower Ground Floor, 1123 Novaliches Plaza Mall, Quirino Highway corner Ramirez, Barangay Novaliches Proper, District V, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Bingo Station granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. the holding of Electronic Bingo Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. the operation of an Electronic Bingo Station shall not include playing of games not related to or other than Electronic Bingo;
3. the operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below twenty-one (21) years of age or students of any school, college or university;
4. Easy E-Bingo Incorporated shall remit a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution, in accordance with Section 25, Article III of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended; and
5. this Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferable, and site-address specific.


