A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO ALLOW THE USE OF THE QUEZON CITY COMMUNITY CENTER, FREE OF CHARGE TO ACCREDITED NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs), PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs), AND OTHER ACCREDITED ORGANIZATIONS IN QUEZON CITY

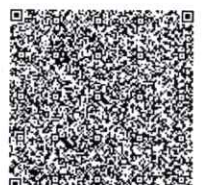

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, in recognition of the contributions of such organizations to the welfare of the residents of the City, desires to provide support by allowing the use of the Quezon City Government facility registered under Transfer Certificate of Title No. MT-1356 (hereinafter referred to as the "Quezon City Community Center") and located at Lot No. 267, at the corner of Mother Ignacia and Don A. Roces Avenues, Barangay Paligsahan, free of charge to accredited NGOs, POs, and other accredited organizations;

WHEREAS, Section 36 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "A local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction";

WHEREAS, there is a need to authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into agreements for the use of the facilities in the Quezon City Community Center, free of charge to NGOs, POs, and other accredited organizations of Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to allow the use of the Quezon City Community Center, free of charge to accredited non-governmental organizations (NGOs), people's organizations (POs), and other accredited organizations in Quezon City.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, or her duly authorized representative, to enter into agreements for the use of the facilities within the Quezon City Community Center, free of charge to accredited NGOs, POs, and other persons, organizations, and entities deemed qualified by the City.


