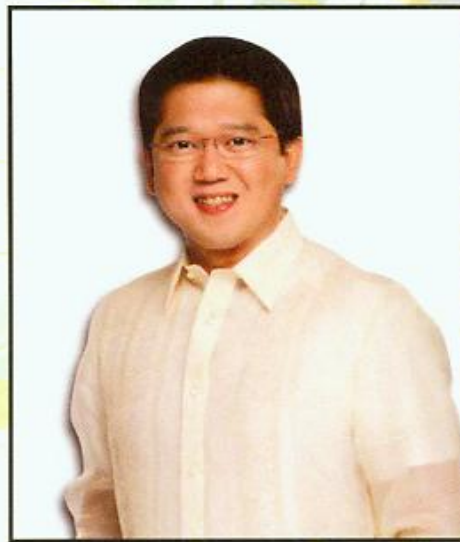



Seventy-two years ago, a city intended to be the nation's new capitol was borne out of the dream of its founding father Philippine Commonwealth President Manuel Quezon, to establish a workmen's paradise where everyone can live decently in a breathable environment, an economically-viable community that is self-sustaining, and a socially progressive niche for people to attain their aspiration and endeavors. Its inception inevitably led not just to the fulfilment of the visions of the late Commonwealth President, but also to the opening of immense development possibilities for a great city in the making.

Now, we happily regard Quezon City as one of the country's premier cities, often acclaimed for best practices and monumental achievements even by international bodies and institutions. It has established a sound financial standing within the last decade, making it possible to advance needed-infrastructure programs that hasten business growth, as well as implement social development programs that uplift every community's quality of life in terms of education, health, sanitation, employment and livelihood. We advocate systems efficiencies by computerizing services we give to the public such as tax assessment and payment, business permit and building permit application and renewal; thus, making our bureaucracy less dependent on human subjectivity that gives room for corruption and red tape.

At the House of Representatives, we complement the development agenda of the city by passing meaningful legislative measures that bolster competitive growth. I authored House Bill 04374 providing for the institutionalization of strategic volunteerism-based multi-sectoral public-private partnership framework in all local government and private stakeholders as the government rewards private sector initiatives with fair incentives. I also co-authored House Bill 03794 distributing the tangentially massive Second Legislative District of Quezon City into three districts so that advancing the welfare of the people can be a more manageable task.

After building up a P500 million medical facility, we transform the old Quezon City General Hospital into a full-pledge medical center as we amend its charter; thus, renaming it, "Quezon City General Hospital Medical Center." We also provide legislative backing in authorizing another government hospital in Quezon City, the Quirino Memorial Medical Center, to operate as a 500-bed medical facility from its original mandate to operate as a 350-bed hospital.

As we move forward towards strengthening Quezon City's position as the Philippines' most competitive city, we recognize the indispensable efforts of nameless heroes and heroines who made possible the city's considerable evolution for the last 72 years. We give credit to our leaders who untiringly work hard to bring our city towards greater heights. We honor the men and women who contribute their talents and efforts in invigorating economic activities in the city by doing good in their jobs, faithfully paying their taxes, and abiding by our laws and ordinances. We thank everyone for doing their part in establishing a productive community of people bound by a common aspiration to create an idea and quality community for all.

If President Quezon would see how far his great city has gone, I am sure he would wear a smile in awe and gratitude for everyone who, not only made his visions possible, but also brought his ideas a bit further to embrace the collective dreams of the people for promising community that now significantly shapes the nation's economic, social and political milieu.


"The Comedy King", Versatile Movie, Stage, TV-Radio Comedy

In both his personal and professional lives, he rose from the bottom. Born to hardworking working class parents in Tondo, he is now enjoying the comforts of wealth, and being a loving patriarch of an extended family. Professionally, he rose from the ranks, watching movies in vintage theaters in Manila while selling peanuts, watermelon seeds, and jicama snacks. World War II found him doing odd jobs shining shoes, attaching buttons to shirts, stevedoring, and horse-and-buggy driving, while watching stage shows at Life and Avenue Theaters, during his free time, imbibing performing lessons from Pugo, Tugo, Benny Mack and Bayani Casimiro. In his early performing years, and during the war, he appeared in stage shows as chorus dancer. He adopted the name Golay.


Among his early patrons were Pancho Magalona and Dr. Jose "Doc" Perez who got him as a contract star in Sampaguita Pictures. The early years found him playing gay roles. It was the show John En Marsha, with Nida Blanca, which served as the watershed event in his professional life, then followed by other hit TV and movie shows, such as Home Along Da Riles As they say, the rest is history.

Dolphy's professional life is indeed an inspiration to many aspiring cinema, stage, and TV- Radio talents, that hardwork and persistence could indeed payoff eventually. The Comedy King has entertained generations of Filipinos, giving joy and laughter to many amidst hardships and difficulties. A supremely talented multi-media performer, a loving partner, father and grandfather, at 83 years of age, he claims in his biographical book, "Hindi Ko ito Narating Mag-isa." Indeed for generations he was not alone for he has always been in the company of his loyal and loving fans.



He is credited for the great success of one of the country's mass media and entertainment corporate network systems, the GMA Network.

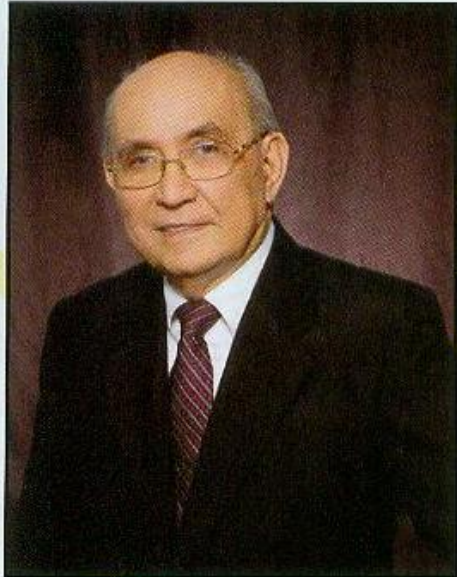
